Indiana University School of Law – Indianapolis

Since Professor George E. Edwards established the IU Law’s Overseas Summer International Human Rights Law Internship Scholarship Program in 1997, a total of 82 J.D. and LL.M. students had interned up to 2008 in the following:

- *49 foreign countries in all the six continents;*
- *11 U.S. states outside of Indiana;*
- *Puerto Rico (a U.S. territory); and*
- *Columbus, Indiana*

Throughout this 12-year period, these 82 interns had rendered pro bono legal services to 82 organizations based in the U.S. and abroad in the field of international human rights law. Three of these 82 organizations availed of the interns’ pro bono legal services at their different country offices. These organizations include the following:

- *United Nations Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (New York, U.S. and Geneva, Switzerland);*
- *Bridges Across Borders (Phnom Penh, Cambodia; Chiang Mai, Thailand; and Hanoi, Vietnam); and*
- *Casa Alianza (San Jose, Costa Rica; Tegucigalpa, Honduras; Mexico City, Mexico; and Managua, Nicaragua)*
